Across the Street and Around the World

"Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen." (-The Lord Jesus Christ-Matthew 28:19-20)

Lanakila Baptist Church has faithfully supported missionaries from its start in 1967. In the last 56 years Lanakila has given \$1,756,000 through faith promise which specifically goes to missionaries and missionary projects. That is an average of \$31,357 a year. This year we have given almost \$33,000 to glory of God. There have been years when Lanakila was larger and gave more. In 1998 Lanakila gave over \$77,000 which was the highest amount given in a year. Hopefully we can see our giving to missions increase each year. Your faithful giving means that we can help support 44 missionaries around the world.

It is also unique that all Lanakila's pastors have been missionaries. Our founding pastor and pastor Wylge were missionaries to Hawai'i and our other pastors were missionaries in other parts of the world before taking the reins of Lanakila. Each of these pastors had a passion to see souls saved both across the street and around the world.

I praise the Lord for allowing me to pastor Lanakila and for the faithful givers who help sustain this ministry and our missionaries. Given the circumstances of the past couple of year we are doing better than expected.

Let us not be content to give to missions. Let's develop a heart for the souls of men, women, teenagers, and children. I believe the Lord's coming is near. Let's keep faithfully and sacrificially giving so that others can take the gospel where we can't. But let us also be faithful servants of Christ and reach out to those that our missionaries cannot...those people who live next door, across the street, your fellow workers, your friends, and especially your family.

Did you know...

What is Theology Proper / Paterology?

Theology Proper or Paterology is the study of God and His attributes. Theology Proper means the study of God, and Paterology means the study of the Father. Therefore, Theology Proper or Paterology teaches is what the Bibles says about God the Father, the first Person of the Triune Godhead, and it answers several important questions about God such as: Does God exist? What are the attributes of God? What does the Bible teach about the Trinity? And, is God sovereign, or do we have a free will?

Theology Proper discusses God's omnipresence, omniscience, omnipotence, and eternity. It teaches us about Who God is and what He does. Paterology focuses on how God the Father is distinct from God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. That information is important because the only way we can properly relate to God is by knowing Who He is and what He does. Many people have unbiblical perceptions about God that negatively impacts how they understand Him. Some people see God as a brutal tyrant, with no love or grace. Other people see God as a loving friend, with no justice or anger. Both of those perceptions are wrong. God is full of love, mercy, and grace; and at the same time He is righteous, holy, and just. God grants mercy and sends judgment. God punishes sin and forgives sin. God allows believers into Heaven and sends unbelievers to Hell. Theology Proper/Paterology gives us a more complete understanding of Who God is and what He does.

As mere humans, we will never fully understand everything about God the Father. However, Romans 11:33 helps to summarize Theology Proper/Paterology: "O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! how unsearchable are his judgments, and his ways past finding out!" Yes, we will never fully understand God, but let us remember to thank Him everyday for continually revealing Himself to us. – Pastor James
