## DID YOU KNOW...

What is Christian Eschatology?

Eschatology is the study of what the Bible says is going to happen in the end times. Many Christians think that Eschatology is an area of theology that should be avoided. While it is true that Eschatology is not as crucial as Christology or Soteriology. That does not mean that it is unimportant to our Biblical worldview. The way we understand Eschatology affects how we live and what to expect regarding God's plan. Some important issues in Eschatology are as follows:

1. What is the Rapture? The word "rapture" is not literally in the Bible. However, the concept of the Rapture is clearly taught in Scripture. The Rapture is when God will remove all believers from the earth to pour out His righteous judgment on the earth during the Tribulation period.
2. When will the Rapture happen in relation to the Tribulation? Will the Rapture occur before the Tribulation, at the middle of the Tribulation, or the end of the Tribulation? The majority of Christians believe in a pre-tribulation rapture.
3. What is the Second Coming of Jesus Christ, and why is it important for Him to return? When is Christ going to return? What will be the signs of Christ's return?
4. Is the millennium literal or figurative? The fulfillment of God's covenants and promises rests on a literal, physical, future kingdom.

Eschatology helps us to understand the Bible's prophetic message and how to live our lives in response to what God is going to do in the end times. There is a lot of controversy in Eschatology, but that does not mean that we should not study and understand what the Bible teaches about the end times. An understanding of Eschatology will eliminate any fears we have about the future. Our God is sovereign, He has a plan, and it will all unfold according to His perfect will and timing. That is a great encouragement to everyone who is in Christ! – Pastor James
